DTD Cheat Sheet

Element Occurrence Indicators:

<!ELEMENT article (title, author+, pn?, p+)>

- ✓ no indicator = an element must appear once and only once
- ✓ + = indicates an element must appear once, but may repeat
- ★ = an element may appear zero or more times; it is optional, but if it is used, it may be used as often as necessary
- ✓ ? = means it can appear either once or not at all; i.e. it is optional, but not repeatable.

Attribute Types:

- CDATA character data -- ASCII text
 - <!ATTLIST linegroup n CDATA #IMPLIED>
- **ENUMERATED LIST** the attribute value must be one of the series specified
 - <!ATTLIST note location (foot | end | inline) > or
 - <!ATTLIST note location (foot | end | inline) 'foot' >
- **ID** a unique identifier for this element instance. Must begin with a letter, underscore or a colon
- **IDREF** a reference to an ID attribute which takes the same name as the ID (used to create a link)
- IDREFS a list of IDREF separated by spaces

Attribute Values:

- must be used #REQUIRED
- whether it is optional #IMPLIED
- it is predetermined #FIXED
